**DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAM/COURSE:**

Fishes & Loaves Vocational Center offers a 126-hour Nurse Aide Training Program approved by the Illinois Department of Public Health and the Illinois Board of Higher Education. This comprehensive program prepares students to take the Illinois Nurse Aide Competency Exam and begin work as safe, caring, and effective Certified Nursing Assistants. Instruction is divided into 63 hours of classroom learning, 21 hours of lab practice, and 42 hours of supervised clinical experience.

Students learn essential nursing assistant principles and develop hands-on skills in communication, patient safety, recognizing emergencies, and providing daily care such as grooming, feeding, mobility assistance, and vital sign monitoring. Training prepares graduates for entry-level positions in hospitals, nursing homes, hospice, and home health settings. Upon successful completion, students are awarded a certificate of completion and are eligible for certifying testing.

**PREREQUISITE COURSES & OTHER REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO PROGRAM /COURSE:**

- Must have a reading level of 8.0 and math level of 4.5 GLE
- Must be able to pass criminal background check and drug test
- Must complete and present 2 Step TB Skin tests.
- Immunization record
- Flu vaccine during flu season

**PROGRAM/COURSE OBJECTIVES:**

Upon completion of the program, students will be able to:

- Perform all Illinois-required basic nursing assistant skills safely and accurately.
- Apply infection control procedures, including proper hand hygiene and PPE use.
- Provide compassionate assistance with activities of daily living (ADLs).
- Measure and record vital signs and report changes in patient condition.
- Communicate effectively with patients, families, and healthcare staff.
- Demonstrate professionalism, confidentiality, and respect for patient rights.
- Use safe body mechanics and proper techniques for positioning, lifting, and transfers.
- Assist in the care of residents with cognitive impairments and special needs.
- Maintain a safe, clean, and comfortable care environment.
- Meet the competencies required to sit for the Illinois Nurse Aide Competency Exam.

**REFUND / CANCELLATION POLICY**

**The Student's Right to Cancel**

The student has the right to cancel the initial enrollment agreement until 5:00 pm on the (5<sup>th</sup>) business day after the student has been admitted to Fishes & Loaves Vocational and Literacy Center . If the right to cancel is not given to any prospective student at the time the agreement is signed, then the student has the right to cancel the agreement at any time and receive a refund on all monies paid to date within (30) days of cancellation.

**Cancellation should be submitted to The Student Services Office in writing.**

## **Refund Policy after start of class:**

The school shall adhere to the following refund policy. (A) If notification of cancellation by the student is given to the school prior to the first day of class attendance, all tuition and books and material charges shall be refunded to the student or sponsor, excluding the enrollment fee. (B) If notice of cancellation is given after the student's completion of the first day of class attendance but prior to the student's completion of 5% of the course of instruction; the school will retain the enrollment fee, 10% of the tuition plus the cost of any books and materials, which have been provided by the school. (C) If a student has completed in excess of 5% of the course of instruction, the school will retain the enrollment fee and the cost of books and materials that have been provided, and an amount computed prorate by days in class plus 10% of tuition and other instructional charges up to completion 60% of the theory portion of instruction. When the student has completed in excess of 60% of the course of instruction, the school will retain the enrollment fee and the entire tuition and other charges.

**Cancellation of Classes:** Classes may be cancelled for insufficient enrollment. When a class is cancelled for insufficient enrollment, all tuition and fees will be refunded within 30 days after the class cancellation. (see catalog for specific programs)
